What We Believe

Education is the key to opportunity and it's a ticket out of poverty.

What We Do

We offer free remedial classes to underprevilidged children in Taiwan's rural areas.

Why We Care

According to the Comprehensive Assessment Program(CAP), about 30% of Taiwan's junior high school graduates every year fall into the C category in English and mathematics, which means they don't have basic competence in these two subjects, posing a challenge both to personal and national development.

Why Rural Areas

- Over half junior high graduates are C-students in CAP
- Most are from a poor and dysfunctional family
- Lack of guidance to develop positive attitudes on learning
- No educational resourses after school

What Poor Kids Need

- A second chance to acquire basic English literacy and mathematical skills
- Encouraging and emphatic adults to help them cultivate values and purpose
- Opportunities to discover their talents and explore their potential.

Remedial Classes: How We Do It

Teachers

- Local residents trained to be teachers
- Passing on visions and values
- On-the-job training in class management
- Partnership with schools and community
- Regular support group meeting



Remedial Classes: How We Do It

Students

- Free daily classes to kids from Grds 3-9
- Placement tests before classes begin
- tailor-made materials with clear goals
- 5-8 kids each class to ensure effective learning
- Regular academic and emotional assessment
- Student counseling available if needed





Students' Performance

Among those who regularly attend our remedial classes for one year, 80% catch up with their peers in English at school and 40% in math. These kids' basic knowledge is strengthened and their confidence gets boosted at the same time.
